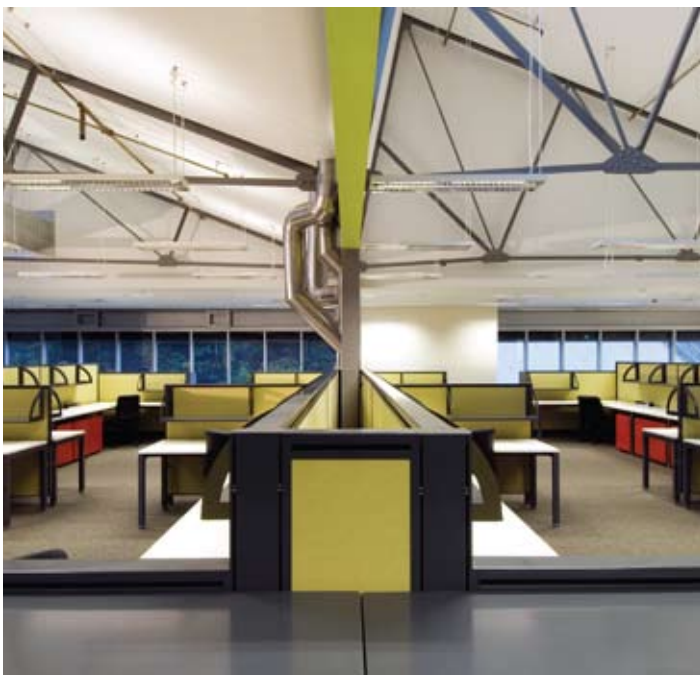

This project involved collaboration between the South Australian Government, University of Adelaide and the Department of Environment & Heritage.

It is the only Ancient DNA facility in the southern hemisphere and is one of only three in the world.

The project includes a DNA laboratory and office accommodation housed in the heritage listed Botanical Gardens Tram Barn.

The design of the laboratory areas involved a very high level of technical consultation and JPE provided a unique solution that satisfied the stringent contamination requirements with a strong emphasis on natural light, colour and detail.



This project received a RAIA Commendation award for Interior Architecture in 2007.
